

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Who may be issued a Winer's/Winegrower's Public Celebration Permit?

Only the holder of a New Mexico Winer's or Winegrower's license. The license holder must complete the application, indicating his license number and name of business.

2. What type of event requires a Winer's/Winegrower's Public Celebration Permit?

If the event is a private function and no charge is made for the wine either directly or indirectly, and if the attendance at the event is limited to bona fide invited guests, no Permit is required. However, if there is to be a charge for the wine served or to attend, or if the attendance is not limited to specifically identifiable invited guests, then a Permit must be obtained for the event.

3. What is the fee?

The fee is \$10.00 per day on which the event is held, which cannot exceed 5 days unless the Director approves a longer time, and cannot be more than 12 hours per day.

4. When do you apply?

Application for the Permit must be filed at least 10 days prior to the date of the event. If it is not filed within 10 days, there is an additional \$25.00 expedition fee in order to process the permit.

5. Who can provide the wine to be served?

Only the holder of the Winer's/Winegrower's license can provide the wine to be served.

6. What if there are sales of wine?

If there are sales of wine, the total gross receipts from the sales must be reported to the Taxation & Revenue Department on the tax number of the Winer's/Winegrower's licensee.

7. Who can sell and serve the wine?

Only the employees of the holder of the New Mexico Winer's/Winegrower's license who obtains the permit can sell and dispense the wine.

8. What are the hours and days of the operation?

Monday through Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to Midnight; Sunday, Noon to Midnight.

9. What if the event is to be held on a Sunday?

The local option district where the event is to be held must have authorized Sunday sales.

10. Can wine be removed from the area of the event?

The licensee is authorized to dispense wine by the drink for consumption at the event. By-the-drink dispensed wine cannot be removed from the area of the event. The licensee is authorized to dispense wine in unbroken packages. The unbroken packages may be removed from the area of the event.

13. May a Winer's/Winegrower's Public Celebration Permit be issued within 300 feet of a church or school?
